



Total Fees Payable	\$544.20	Payable upon registration





Student Care Assistance Fees (SCFA)

- Student care subsidies are provided by MSF. The SCFA
 Scheme is available to families whose gross monthly
 household income does not exceed \$4,500 or gross per
 capita income not exceeding \$1,125.
- The application and quantum of subsidy are subject to approval by the Ministry of Social and Family Development's (MSF).
